Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>The BLDEA's Shri B M Patil institute of nursing sciences by excellence and eminence, its status has become a center for life-long learning for both faculty and the students. The learning process commences right from the day opens for the new academic year and proceeds step by step till the end of university examination. The institution has developed a name for itself in providing nursing education in the country. The college is chosen destination to study nursing for the students from various parts of the country. The process of admitting student is on the basis of their performance in the previous qualifying examination and the student who fulfills the eligibility criteria as per apex body [INC]. However 20% of the graduate [Only B.sc [n] and 25% of the post graduate student admissions are done by the government through Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore. The fresher's are given an orientation programme to introduce them to the nursing course and to acclimatize with the institution ethics and functioning. The teaching-learning process involves a well designed teaching plan with specific learning objectives. The students are moulded to serve with compassion, care and evidenced –based practices as they are exposed to the 1200 bedded multi speciality hospital. The college and the hospital are in the same campus. The college is equipped with all necessary facility for effective teaching –learning process. There are 68 teaching faculties are actively involving in teaching-learning and evaluation process. The college plans and organizes the teaching-learning and evaluation schedules at the beginning of the year along with academic calendar. The institution uses the following teaching-learning methods; lecture method, didactic lectures, discussion and interactive methods such as bedside clinics, nursing rounds and practical demonstration and power point presentations. Dummies, manikins, VCD and simulated teaching, are additionally used for teaching basic nursing skills. Skill lab is also utilized by the teaching faculty for students where ever it is needed.</p> <p>As per the curriculum the departments will take active participation in organizing departmental visits with prior intimation followed with supervision like old age home visit, rehabilitation center and blood bank etc. Outreach programmes and field visit to milk diary, water purification center, sewage plants and urban/rural health centers are organized as a part of community field experience. Both student and faculties are involving in conducting continuing nursing education programmes like seminar, symposium, workshops and conferences with use of A V Aids. The nursing procedures are taught in the respective laboratory and simultaneously the re-demonstrations are taken by the student then student are permitted to do procedure under the supervision of ward staff/clinical instructor. During clinical posting the student is supervised by clinical supervisors and hospital staffs. The clinical hours are planned as per the requirements laid down by INC which differs form course to course. The academic committee will provide information prior to the beginning of the month for both student and teacher regarding their wards for duty and supervision. Clinical requirements are going to verified with the subject in charges.</p> <p>The students are encouraged to attend the conferences /seminars/workshops held within and outside the institution. Guest lectures are arranged whenever it requires. The education and administration tours are organized by the respective subject in charges to various specialty hospitals and colleges. The average pass percentage of college is 90% which is more than the affiliated university percentage. The college had various awards in university since from 2013 onwards in both postgraduate and graduate course. The institutional head/ principal will collect feedback from the students of various courses whenever it is needed. Formative evaluation is conducted by the unit heads and subject teacher periodically. The institution has introduced the evaluation of the teachers by the students through an evaluation proforma which is analysed by the principal and the feedback is then given to the concerned faculty through personal interview. Feedback mechanism of the non teaching staff is done whenever it requires. The faculty and students keep pace/update their knowledge with the recent development in the various subjects by referring journals, magazines, attending conferences ,seminars, workshops and online resources such as HELINET. The post graduate students are encouraged to conduct intervention-based studies. The schedule for examination is published in the Rajiv Gandhi university of health sciences website well in advance. Our institution is recognized as both theory/practical examination centers for both UG and PG. During examination the students are supervised by the invigilators and observer and flying squad appointed by university during the exams and any unfair behavior during the exams is duly reported to the Rajiv Gandhi university of health sciences Bangalore.</p>
